RULES FOR ABATEMENTS:

Complete an Application for Abatement form and return it to the Fire District office.

Attach any supporting documentation to better explain your request. In your description, please indicate the date the problem began, or the date you became aware of the problem, and the date of the repair, if applicable. If requesting an abatement for excessive water usage, provide a copy of the repair bill from a licensed plumber or dated receipts showing the parts purchased to make repairs.

An average usage, based on the previous four billing periods, will be used to calculate an abatement for excessive water usage.

No more than ONE abatement will be issued per property location for excessive water usage issues.

Abatements will only be given towards charges applied within the last 12 months.

All abatements are at the discretion of the Prudential Committee.
